

Admission requirements: be over 18 years old; clear criminal records certificate; valid firearms license (for Italians only); be in good physical and mental health; no previous experience with firearms is required;

Personal equipment needed: 9mm pistol (striker fired models: example Glock 19/17 - Smith & Wesson M&P M2.0 Compact - Beretta APX - CZ P10) + 3 magazines; internal kydex holster; belt pistol magazine pouch for 2 magazines; baseball cap; sunglasses; headphones (ear protectors);
200 ammunition of 9mm;

Necessary clothing: comfortable jeans or tactical pants (authorized colors: olive green, sand, black); t-shirt (better if simple, white, black, dark blue, olive green, coyote, khaki); checkered "tactical" shirt; windproof-rain jacket (sober colors, avoid flashy designs: better if black, dark blue, olive green, coyote, khaki); shoes

Objective of the course: the Pistol Basic course is certainly one of the most important. It lays the solid foundation for the complete tactical structure of the operator to be built. Thanks to the basic program it is possible to acquire the essential basics of safe weapon handling, grip, main shooting positions standing, sitting and kneeling, dynamic action, displacements, running, tactical and rapid changes of the magazine, the awareness of the tactical environment, the strategy of the combat system, the differences between the various tactical carry of the weapon. Differences between the traditional and the modern Israeli system. Notions of ballistics, shelters and hiding places. Already from the basic course, through realistic scenarios, we are committed to creating people aware of the tactical environment, who know how to solve weapon malfunctions, who know how to discriminate between targets and civilians, able to move easily and safely, handling the weapon with firmness but without ever sacrificing safety, one's own and that of bystanders. Objective of the course: the Pistol Intermediate course allows you to access a higher level. Thanks to it you will begin to face one of the most difficult topics, the Israel Limited Penetration Method, the Israeli method that allows operators engaged in Counter Terrorism (Active Shooter) actions to reduce the threat by maintaining a safe position, behind a cover and, only then, enter the room / hall / area where the threat is and neutralize it. In the intermediate level you will acquire competence in approaching the room, the wall, the shelter, the door and studying the correct shooting positions and the entry method that allows operators the minimum exposure to possible enemy fire. We can say with certainty that the intermediate level represents the most difficult course, precisely because it involves the study of complicated movements to learn, in this initial phase.





Advanced

In the intermediate level you will acquire competence in approaching the room, the wall, the shelter, the door and you will study the correct shooting positions and the method of entry that allows operators the minimum, if not zero, exposure to possible enemy fire . Objective of the course: Acquire in-depth knowledge of the ILPM. **Israeli Limited Penetration** is the room clearing method developed and perfected by Israel to manage and resolve episodes of great danger deriving from terrorist attacks with maximum safety. We will teach how to approach and "clean" a room without being forced to enter it, keeping the operator safe and secure throughout the action. In level 1 you will learn to "clean up" a complete environment made up of rooms, corridors, doors, windows and obstacles, in the most effective and safe way, individually, with just the gun and without the support of other operators. The different types of rooms, the different doors, the fixtures, the windows, the angles, the priorities, the research CQB vs the contrast CQB, the materials, the tactical set-up and many other themes that you will discover by participating in this advanced course.

Level 2

(CQB - Israeli Advanced Method) **Single Operative - Carbine**




